

Funding Surgeries for Early Years Music-Making Projects at

Creating Musical Spaces: Origins, Cultures and Childhoods

The National Foundation for Youth Music will be offering free funding surgeries on Tuesday 21st June. These surgeries are an opportunity for a one to one conversation with a Youth Music Grants Officer and will give you the chance to discuss your Early Years Music-Making project, have your Youth Music funding questions answered and get advice about writing your application.

Youth Music funds music-making activity that achieves personal, social and musical outcomes for children and young people in challenging circumstances. We invest in projects working with children and young people who live in England and are aged up to 25 years. One of Youth Music's funding priorities is Early Years and we are looking to fund more high quality projects for children aged 0 – 5.

Surgery sessions are not intended to be a general discussion about the funding Youth Music has available, but an opportunity to discuss a specific project or project idea. We strongly advise that you read the Youth Music

guidance through in advance and come prepared with your project plan and any specific questions you have.

Please note: Youth Music is only open to organisations looking to deliver projects for children living in England.
